Pantomime – we are sorry to say that we have finally decided to cancel our provisional booking with Theatre Severn as payment had to be confirmed this week and there is still the potential risk for cancelling which would have made matters complicated. We will ensure as a school and through the support of the Friends of the School that we will make Christmas special for the children and can always have a Theatre visit in the Spring Term.

Attendance and Arrivals – we realise we cannot make up for lost time but make the plea that children arrive in school in time by 8.50 latest which is the start of our school day. There are activities taking place in class from 8.40 onwards so children are missing out on a part of their education and we need to maximise every minute. It also disrupts the flow of teaching for other children. We also have to monitor attendance on a half termly basis regardless of Covid.

Clothing – we are finding lots of school jumpers in school which have no names and therefore cannot be returned to their owners. Please label all items of clothing to help us retrieve them.

Safeguarding Virtual Visit – the Fire Service visited both Dosbarth Mrs Roberts and Mr McWhinnie to discuss fire safety. The younger children heard the message of "Don't touch, tell." (the danger of touching lighters & matches) and Years 5 &6 heard about Fire Safety in the Home. We always recommend the discussion continues at home. Remembrance Sunday – two minutes of silence took place in school yesterday as a mark of respect. Every class was involved in activities to learn about and reflect on Remembrance.
