Discovery Day – over the last two years we have ensured that we have continued termly with this special day when the children learn about the new topic launch in a very fun, hands on, practical way. We are so pleased to say we returned this week to our good practice of collaboration throughout the school. All the children were put into 4 groups of all ages to access 4 different classrooms. It was so lovely to observe older children supporting younger ones and sometimes vice versa. The four class Teachers planned and provided the following experiences.

Mrs Davies – i) Physical Fingers with Dough Disco - building up our finger muscles following dough disco exercises. ii) Mindfulness Colouring - Diolch Sharon for creating our very own Llansantffraid Primary School mindfulness colouring for us to exercise our mental health muscles. Iii) Stop Motion - We were Busy Bees and collaborated to create a mini movie of different exercises we could carry out. Iv) Co-ordination Skills - We challenged ourselves to beat the record in our co-ordination of ball skills.

Mrs Roberts – We used our fine motor skills to sort objects into colour categories, played games involving balance and accuracy and created pattern using small movements.

Miss Morris – The children discussed different objects / animals that could move around before we moved onto the focus of 'Puppets'. The children then shared their knowledge of different types of puppets such as hand, string, wooden etc. The challenge of the day was to create a 'String Snake Puppet' with the different resources. To do this, the children had to watch a step-by-step video very carefully and listen to the instructions. The children were fantastic throughout, showing different characteristics of our Growth Mindset characters and it certainly looked like they were proud of what they had achieved. Da iawn blant!

Mr McWhinnie – We developed cricketing skills across the ages, starting with warm up games, moving on to sending, receiving, fielding and catching. The older children were brilliant at looking after the younger ones and providing nurture and encouragement. Luckily the day was dry to pursue outdoors with the 4 groups.

Visitors – thank you to Dewi Morris from Severn Rivers Trust for coming to school to provide an assembly about National Fish Migration Day. He then went along with Dosbarth McWhinnie to the River Cain near where it joins the Vyrnwy for a study of the creatures found within which then led to an excellent numeracy task creating a biotic index data. 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
