Summer Term Topic – Heroes

The children in our Reception and Year 1 class have been thinking about our term topic "Heroes". The children have decided that they are very interested in following the theme of Superheroes! When we have talked a little more about what a "Hero" means to us we are also going to investigate how God and Jesus also represent a hero. We have also decided that we have heroes all around us! In our families, at school and in our cynefin. We are also very interested to find out and share our ideas about how we can become an even better hero to all the people around us that we care about! We will know what to look out for ... "When a hero comes along!".

In Years 2 and 3 we have discussed what the meaning of a 'Hero' is and generated some questions we would like to find out the answers to. Linking our thoughts very carefully to the four purposes of the curriculum we will be Healthy Confident Individuals by finding out all about medicines and how they are made and the heroes that invented them. We are going to be Enterprising Creative Contributors by designing air powered vehicles to help superheroes escape and designing our own superheroes. Ethically Informed Citizens through looking into famous heroes from the past, present and future and locating these heroes on maps. Finally we will become Ambitious Capable Learners through learning how to make suspenseful music for hero films and creating pop up cards to reward the heroes we know.'

Children in Years 4/5 were excited to find out that our new topic for the Summer Term is 'Heroes' and were keen to write their ideas down. We began by sharing our thoughts and feelings about what the word 'Hero' means to them. This then helped the children to think of ideas linked to the Areas of Learning. Throughout the term, the children would like to write a biography about their Hero, design a 'Superheroes Headquarters' using their skills of area and perimeter, look back in History to identify people who have influenced our world, recreate stunt moves from famous movies, and finally, design a hero in their very own eyes.

The year 6 class collaborated and identified several aspects of the topic they wish to investigate. Some of these include; investigating properties of different materials to design a super hero suit, using their research and DCF skills to create biographies of their heroes, undertake a humanities enquiry to identify the heroic actions of people in WW2 and create their own super hero, turning this into a comic book using their DCF skills.

Community Links - we welcome Chloe Dean (Year 6) and Lauren Slater (Years 4/5) from the University of Chester on their teaching practice placement with us this half term. We hope they enjoy their time with us.

Blwyddyn 5/6 enjoyed a day at Ysgol Llanfyllin this week to prepare for transition in a cluster project with other schools.

Staffing – we welcome Mr Christian Rushton to our school to cover Mrs Davies Welsh Sabbatical for the term. We hope he enjoys his time with us until the summer.

REPEAT - IMPORTANT School Meals

Please note that after Easter school meals will go up to £2.45.

With the rollout over the coming year, we still encourage all families who are eligible to apply to Powys as per previous eFSM (eligible for Free School Meals). Schools get money to support these children in the classroom, provide free breakfast club, help towards eg costly residential visits etc. The grant funding supports our staffing structure which we don't want to lose.

Free school meals - Powys County Council

If you are on a low income, we can help you with the cost of school meals for any pupil in full time education.

If you register for free school meals, even if your child decides not to have a school lunch, you can:

- Save up to £400 a year for each primary school child
- Help your school and other schools in Powys to benefit from funding because you have registered
- Registering for Free School Meals might also qualify you for other help and assistance.

To register is easy and confidential. You don't have to tell the school.
