Covid Self-Isolation – as of today's date Wales isolation rules have changed as follows:

“You should take a lateral flow test (LFT) on day 5 of your self-isolation period and a second lateral flow test the next day (you should aim to take it 12-24 hours after your first test). This will help determine if you are still infectious and potentially pass COVID-19 to others. You should not take a LFT before day 5 of your self-isolation period because the risk of remaining infectious and therefore passing the infection onto others before this period is significantly higher. You can leave self-isolation after 5 full days (on day 6 of your self-isolation period) if you test positive you should remain in self-isolation until you can return 2 consecutive negative LFT tests, or until day 10, whichever is sooner.”
