Our termly 'Prynhawn Cymraeg' was full of linked activities and we also tied in with our special day of the month on 'Cynefin' (our local environment) and the Cwricwlwm Cymreig (study of Wales). Loads of hands on activities to enhance the learning.

Attendance – we are still having some families regularly arriving after 8.50 which is our school start time. We don't want children missing out on any crucial minutes of learning but it also causes disruption to the other class children too. Thank you.
