Christian Core Value for this Half Term – Christianity is rich in stories of courage and endurance, both from the Bible and to the present day. Jesus gave his life as a model to be followed and hence was prepared to stand up for what is right in the face of danger and hardship. Courage is about a life-long process of challenging ourselves to be the best that we can be – even when this becomes hard. For children in schools, this could mean the courage to say ‘no’ when everyone else wants you to do something you do not want to do; the courage to stick at a task even when it is difficult or the courage to stand by your beliefs even when people laugh at you. The value is represented by the following verse:-
